

Troop 969 Three Season Camping List

The climate around Shanghai is fairly mild during our camping season of October through May. However, temperatures can drop below freezing and rain can descend on us at any time. Therefore it is essential to plan accordingly. You should always check the 5-day forecast prior to departure, expect the weather to be worse than forecast and then pack accordingly.

Clothing to wear:

When traveling to and from a camp site all scouts should wear their Class A uniform (Tan Shirt, Scout Pants/Shorts, Scout Socks, Scout Belt, and neckerchief)

Footwear (wear one and pack the other)

1 pair lightweight sneakers to wear in camp
1 pair of trekking shoes or lightduty hiking boots for activities

Clothing to pack

2 - Class B Troop 969 t-shirts or polo shirts	Rain Gear (lightweight raincoat or poncho)
Long Pants	Hat (suitable for sun or rain)
Hiking Shorts (as needed)	2 pair Underwear
Red Troop Fleece or jacket	3 pair thick athletic socks
Sweatshirt (1 or 2 depending on season)	Bed Clothes (sweats)

Personal Gear

Tooth Brush	Washcloth
Toothpaste	Bath Towel
Comb	Insect Repellant
Hand wipes	Lip balm
Purell	Sunscreen
Hand Soap	Eyeglasses (as needed)
Toilet tissue (1 roll with core removed)	Sunglasses
Personal first aid kit (for minor wound/blister)	Music instrument
Snacks	Coffee/tea/hot chocolate

Equipment

Sleeping Bag (minimum rated to 30° F)	Mess Kit (Plate, Bowl & Cup)
Sleeping Pad / air mattress	Eating Utensils (Knife, Fork & Spoon)
Back Pack /Duffle Bag	Small Bags for all Gear
Tent w/ground cloth and rain fly (2 scouts per tent)	Large garbage bag, small ziploc bags

Pocket Knife	Notepad
Compass	Watch
Flashlight w/Extra Batteries (no headlamps)	Water Bottle(s) 2 liters/day

Not Allowed (subject to confiscation)
